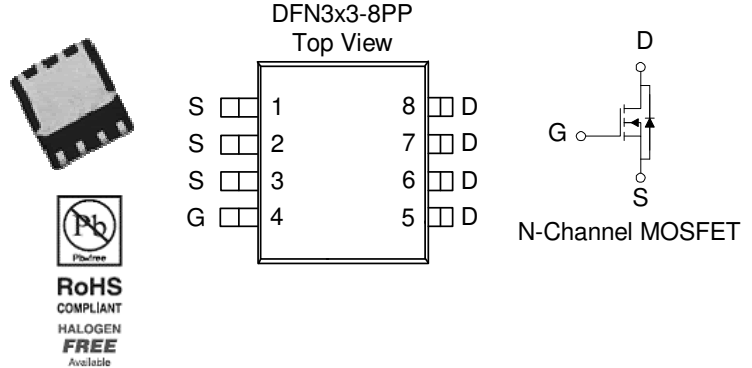


**N-Channel 30-V (D-S) MOSFET**

These miniature surface mount MOSFETs utilize a high cell density trench process to provide low  $r_{DS(on)}$  and to ensure minimal power loss and heat dissipation. Typical applications are DC-DC converters and power management in portable and battery-powered products such as computers, printers, PCMCIA cards, cellular and cordless telephones.

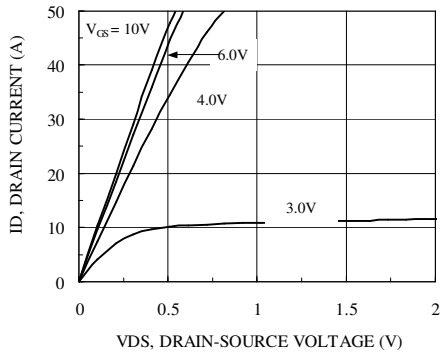


Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics

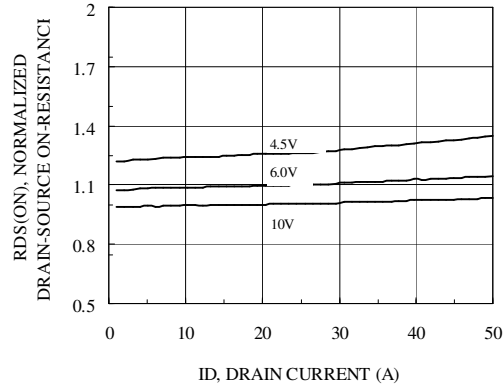


Figure 2. On-Resistance with Drain Current

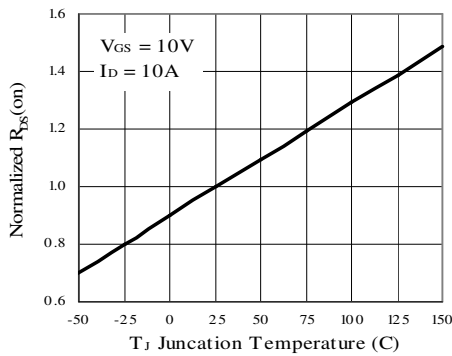


Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature

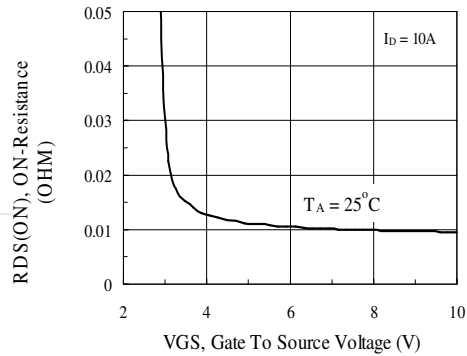


Figure 4. On-Resistance Variation with Gate to Source Voltage

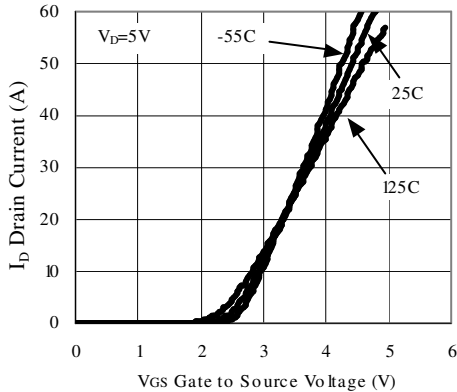


Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics

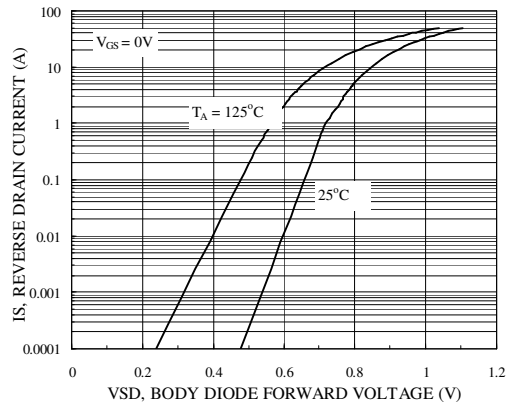


Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature

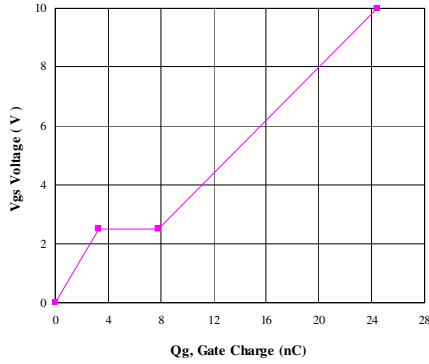


Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics

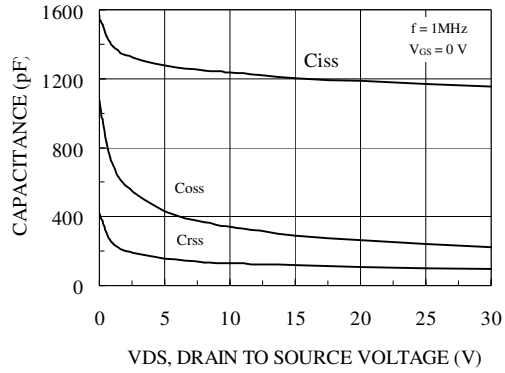


Figure 8. Capacitance Characteristics

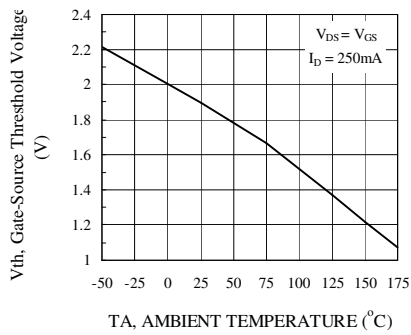


Figure 9. Threshold Vs Ambient Temperature

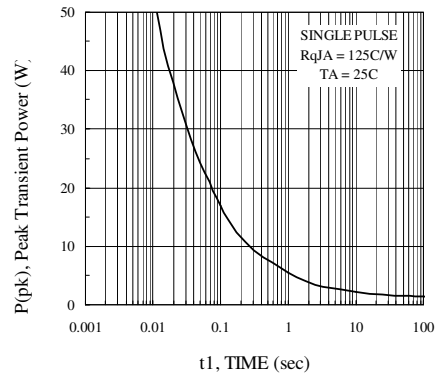


Figure 10. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation

### Normalized Thermal Transient Junction to Ambient

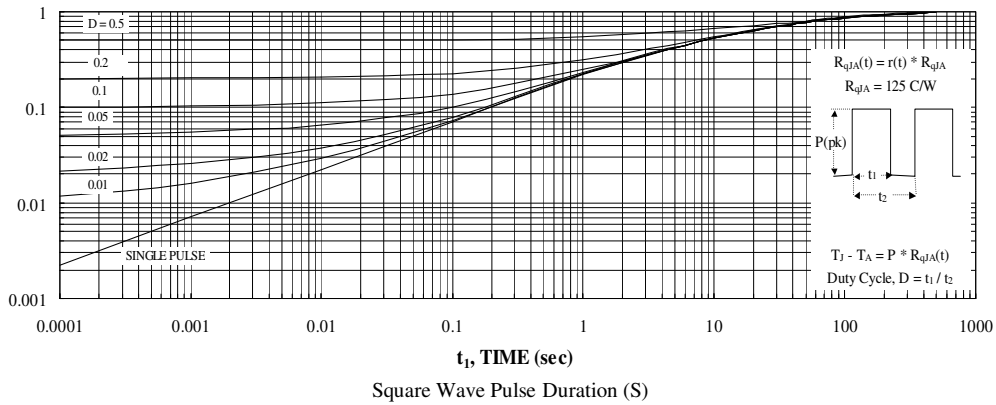
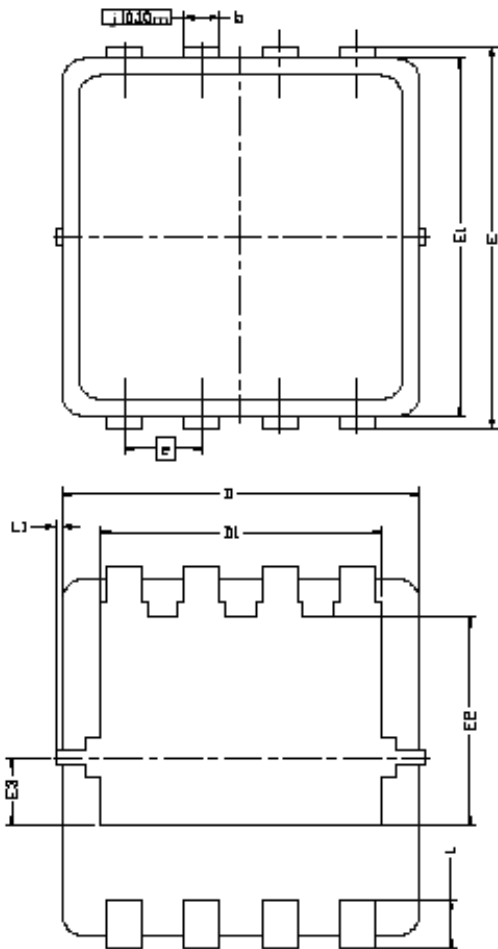


Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve
